

## **RESOLUTION REPEALING MAIL BALLOTING**

WHEREAS, the Township administers local, state, and Federal elections, as required by Minnesota election law;

WHEREAS, the Township may hold elections either by in-person balloting or by mail balloting, at the discretion of the Township Board;

WHEREAS, the Township adopted mail balloting for one or more past elections pursuant to the mail balloting process described in Minnesota Statutes § 204B.45;

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute Section 204B.45 provides for a town of any size not located in a metropolitan county as defined by Minnesota Statutes Section 473.121 to repeal balloting by mail, if adopted;

WHEREAS, the Township seeks to return to in-person balloting;

WHEREAS, the Township Board desires to have a polling place as near to the Township's voters as possible;

WHEREAS, voters may continue to cast ballots by mail using Minnesota's absentee voting process, if they choose to do so;

WHEREAS, notice of a change in the method of election must be given to the County Auditor;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town Board of \_\_\_\_\_ repeals its mail balloting process and shall adopt in-person balloting for all Township elections, beginning \_\_\_\_\_;
